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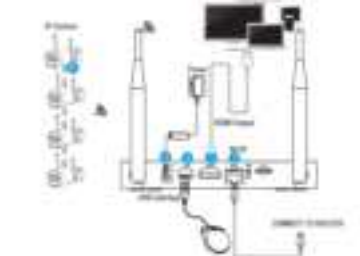

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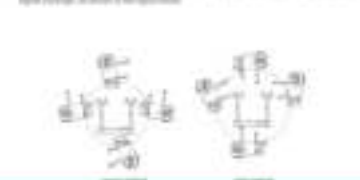
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According to the signal radiation direction of the antenna, it is recommended to adjust the antenna direction to improve the signal quality.

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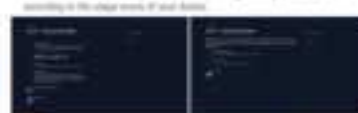
