


## Safety and Precautions

- 1. Use the speaker in appropriate environments.
- 2. Bumps or drops could damage the device.
- 3. Please do not try to open the speaker by yourself or cleaning it with chemical solvent.
- 4. Please turn off the speaker if long time no use.
- 5. In order to protect your hearing. Don't play tracks loudly for long time in case it hurt your heating sense.

The speaker can be paired with only one device at a time. Meaning if you would like to pair the speaker with a second different device, vou must cut off the pairing between device and the speaker. Please see the instructions on page3 Check that your MOKCAO SoundBoom has a sufficient battery charge, the speaker may not connect when the battery has a low charge

Connect the speaker to a charging source and try again pair and connect

Your device may be out of range. Move it closer to within 33 unobstructed feet of your speaker

 $Some older windows computers and operating systems \ may \ have \ difficulty \ pairing \ and \ connecting \ over \ Blue to oth.$ If this occurs it is recommended to connect using the 3.5mm audio cable.

No audio playing from the speaker when connected over Bluetooth

Remove the MOKCAO SoundBoom from the Bluetooth device list on you source device, and then re-pair and connect to the speaker.

 $\label{eq:make-sure-the-volume} \mbox{Make sure the volume is up on your MOKCAO SoundBoom and you source device.}$ Your Bluetooth device may be out of range, move closer within 30 unobstructed feet

Turn your MOKCAO SoundBoom off and back on

No audio playing from the speaker when connected with the 3.5mm audio cable Make sure the 3.5mm audio cable is fully inserted the MOKCAO SoundBoom and device.

Make sure your device is on and playing music

Increase the volume level on the MOKCAO SoundBoom and device Poor sound quality when connected over Bluetooth

Your Bluetooth device may be out of range, move closer within 30 unobstructed feet Remove the MOKCAO SoundBoom from the Bluetooth device list on you source device, and then re-pair and connect to the speaker.

Turn your MOKCAO SoundBoom off and back on.

It cannot be submerged into water partially or fully and after you pick up, you can continue to listen your music.

Note: Please remember to close the AUX port cover before you use the speaker in the water

The cover need to be closed to keep speaker waterproof, otherwise will cause the speaker damaged.


### . The battery may have become fully drained. Charge the MOKCAO SoundBoom use wall charger from a Smartphone/iPhone, then press the power button to turn the speaker on. Then continue charging the battery. And reset the MOKCAO SOUNDBOOM.

Can not pair or connect to Bluetooth

. Check the Bluetooth led light (Blue) to make sure it is quick flashing. If it is keeping blue light the MOKCAO SoundBoom is already connected to another source device.

# **Charging the Battery**

# DC adaptor

Charging battery with DC power supply. Plug DC adaptor to power seat, LED at back strip turns to red, when battery fully charged, LED turn off. Battery

When battery low, the sound message release "battery low", need to recharge. Plug in DC adaptor, LED at back strip turns to red while charging, turns off when battery fully charged.

# Low Charge Remaining Indicator

- When the battery running low the charging led light(Red)will begin until the speaker is fully charged turned off.
- The volume will decrease to preserve the remaining battery charge Fully Charged Indicator

Solid red light indicates that speaker is charging, once the speaker is fully charged the red led light will turn off.

Note: Please remember to close the AUX port cover when not charging. The cover need to be closed to keep speaker waterproof. The power light will begin flashing and will announce "Ready to pair"

## Playing while Charging

You can play the MOKCAO SoundBoom while it is charging

# Power Saving Feature

. The speaker will turn off automatically after 15 minutes if it's not working and is not connected to Bluetooth.

# Turn On and Turn Off

Turn on: Press and hold the power button to turn the speaker on/off. Blue led light indicates that the speaker is on and with voice prompts "Ready Bluetooth Mode". And speaker connect with Bluetooth successfully and with voice prompts "Pairing Successful"

- Bluetooth indicator light fast flashing Blue: Indicators speaker is in pairing mode. . Bluetooth indicator light is Blue: Indicators speaker is connected to a source device and ready to play.

### Pairing & Connecting A: Bluetooth Mode

- $\label{lem:makesure your MOKCAO Sound Boom battery is full charge. \\$
- . Your source device needs to be within 33 unobstructed feet the MOKCAO SoundBoom.
- . If the blue led light is fast flashing the MOKCAO SoundBoom is ready to pair and connect, also with the voice prompts "Ready Bluetooth Mode".
- . If the blue light is not flashing and voice prompts "Pairing Successful" the MOKCAO SoundBoom has automatically reconnected to the last source device the speaker was connected to and is ready to play.

Note: MOKCAO SoundBoom will automatically try to connect to the last source device it was connected to each time it is turned on and that source device is within range. And the speaker remembers the most recent eight devices you used.

MOKCAO SoundBoom can be connected to one device at a time. To pair or connect to different source device, you need to disconnect the currently paired device. To disconnect it, press and hold the Volume up and Volume down button at the same time. The blue light will begin flashing and will announce "Bluetooth Discovering".

B: Audio Cable Mode You can playing your Apple Mac, Laptop and non-Bluetooth devices with the 3.5mm audio cable. Like some older Windows computers and operating systems may have difficulty pairing and connect over Bluetooth. If this occurs it is recommended to connect using 3.5mm audio cable.

Note: The Bluetooth on the MOKCAO SoundBoom is disabled when the 3.5mm audio cable is connected to the speaker. Press the power button to switch to

AUX mode when the speaker is open. Bluetooth will automatically disconnect.

Note: Please remember to close the AUX port cover when not using 3.5mm audio cable. The cover need to be closed to keep speaker waterproof.
