The SAR limit set by the FCC is 1.6 W/kg. * Tests for SAR are conducted with the phone transmitting at its highest specified power level in all tested frequency bands. Bodyworn Operation

For optimal bodyworn operation, to comply with FCC exposure requirements, a minimum separation distance of 10mm must be maintained between the user's body and the handset, including the antenna. Third-party headsets, booties, and similar accessories used by this device should not contain any metallic components that could cause the device to exceed the FCC's SAR limits. Yr wireless phone is a radio transmitting device. It is designed and manufactured to transmit radio signals to a cellular base station. The radio signals are not to exceed the emission limits for exposure to radiofrequency (RF) energy set by the Federal Communications Commission of the United States. These limits are part of the Federal Radio Frequency Protection Regulations (FRP) and are designed to protect the general population from adverse health effects from exposure to RF energy from wireless devices.

The guidelines are based on scientific data that were developed by independent scientific organizations through periodic and thorough evaluation of the safety of all products, regardless of age and health. The exposure standard for wireless mobile phones, a type of personal communication system (PCS) device, is based on the specific absorption rate (SAR), the unit of measurement used to quantify the absorption of RF energy by the human body.

The SAR is a measure of the rate at which RF energy is absorbed by the human body.
