





BLUETOOTH PAIRING




Pairing Mode Sowly Flashing Blue

- 1. Press and hold the Power Button to power on your speaker.
- 2. The LED indicator light will turn blue and flash to indicate that your speaker is in pairing mode.



 Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone.
 Make sure that Bluetooth is turned on. Connect to the device listed as "Mini Speaker".



 The LED indicator light will remain blue and shine steadily to indicate that your speaker is paired with your phone.

TRUE WIRELESS PAIRING

Your speakers can be used individually or both can be used simultaneously. To use both of your speakers together, follow the steps below.

1. Press and hold the Power Buttons on each speaker to turn them ON. Wait 3~5 seconds and your two speakers will pair together. Restart both speakers if they aren't pairing together after an extended period of time.

2. Once your two speakers are paired together, the parent speaker's indicator light will turn blue and flash, while the child speaker's indicator light will turn blue and shine steadily.

3. Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone, make sure the Bluetooth is on. Connect to the device listed as "Mini Speaker".


4. Once your two speakers are both paired together and with your phone, the indicator light on both speakers will remain blue, and the blue indicator light will shine steadily when playing music.

Note:

The buttons on both speakers should be functional.

When you press and hold the Power Button on the parent speaker, both speakers will be turned off. When you press and hold the Power Button on the child speaker, the child speaker will be turned off independently.


USING YOUR SPEAKER



1. Press and hold the Power Button to power on or power off your speaker.



Press the Play/Pause Button to play or pause music.
 Press the Play/Pause Button to answer or end a phone call.
 Press and hold the Play/Pause Button to reject a phone call.



3. You can adjust the volume and playback settings on your phone or audio device.



4. Use the included adhesive stickers (with magnet and without) or the included suction cups to attach your conduction peakers to various surfaces. Your speakers use surface conduction technology to amplify sound when they are placed on hollow surfaces.
