



1. When using earphones for the first time, the left and right ears are successfully paired within 3 seconds after turning on;

2. After the headset is turned on, it automatically enters the pairing state, the indicator light is white and breathing flashes, and the headset prompt tone is "Waiting for connection". At this time, turn on the Bluetooth of the device you want to pair, search for the headset, and click the Bluetooth name "TS06" to pair;

3. The earphones are taken out of the charging compartment, and the left and right earphones are automatically paired and connected back;

Pairing success: When the headset is powered on, the headset automatically enters the search pairing mode, the white light is off, and the Bluetooth is turned on for the first time Disconnect Bluetooth: Manually or ultra distance disconnect Bluetooth, white light breathing flash, headset prompt tone: "waiting for connection";
