I have a few comments on this Application. Depending on your responses, kindly understand there may be additional comments.

- 1.) The label for this transmitter should not contain the FCC logo. FCC logo only applies to computers and computer peripherals which qualify under the DoC authorization procedure. Devices which connect to a computer wirelessly and without any cable do not qualify as a computer peripheral and do not qualify for the FCC logo. On the other hand, the USB receiver will qualify as a computer peripheral and the FCC logo may apply. Please refer to 15.19(b), 15.101, 2.906, 2.909, 2.1072..
- 2.) Was this device tested in three orthogonal planes as required by ANSI C63.4?
- 3.) Please note that the method for determining the -20dB correction factor applied to the radiated test results is incorrect. Please refer to 15.35, especially 15.35(b) and (c). You should have compared the transmit on-time to 10msec, not the 36.1msec as shown in your report.
