
No changes have occurred in the electrical design of the product. The only change being the top cover industrial design and label on the device. The top cover utilizes the same materials and minimum thickness of material. The top cover differences are visual only; consisting of only one LED visible to the end user via light pipe, gloss finish, lower radius fillet on corners, and removal of Ruckus logo and trademark.

The original test results, technical information and relevant documents continue to be representative of and applicable to the changed equipment.
