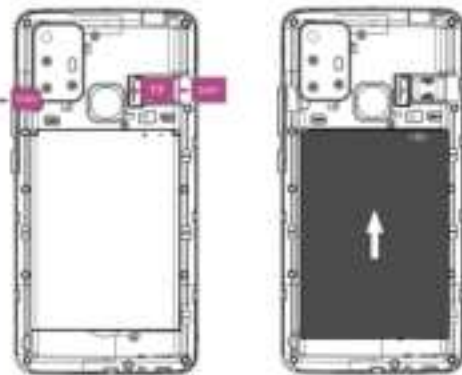
5. Cell phone guidance

6. Mobile card settings

1. Start up the cellphone through a long touch of power button.
2. Follow screen tips and enter Home Screen.
Settings between different SIM cards, (Access SIM) or SIM2 for 3G mobile data and default calling.



5. Safety information

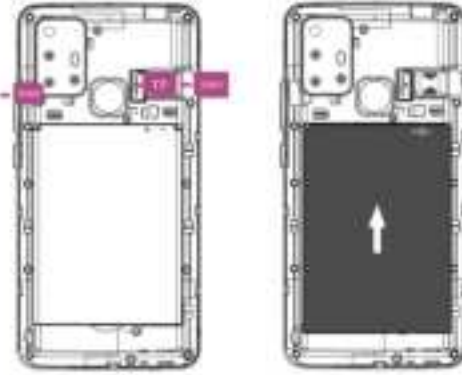

6. Configuración de la tarjeta SIM
