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Question #1: I am very trouble in reviewing this application. The test report provided which included test data from previous application but the test data has been changed. To name one " page 14 of 40, emissions below 1GHz.". The data presented ( test date:Nov.29, 2001) in this section are identical to the one you tested in August 24, 2001. In addition, there are many sections of test data are copied from previous Class II permissive change application. You are caution not to do so in the future application.

For Class II permissive change, it is not necessary to perform all the tests in 15.247. It is test lab responsibilities to perform selected test items in accordance the changes made on the device. You only require to report those tests that have been performed due to the changes. You are not require to cut and paste the previous test data in the Class II permissive change report. If you do so, there is no way for the review to determine which tests were actually performed and which tests were not performed but copied from previous application.

Please go over the test report, delete all test data which were not performed for this Class II permissive change.

Technical review will continue once the revised test report is provided.
