Messaging & Email

Email setup

- 1. From the Home screen > Google 💮 > Gmail 🙀.
- 2. Select **Got It > Add an email address**, then select an email provider.
- 3. Enter your account credentials, such as email address and password. Tap **NEXT** to continue.
- 4. Confirm email account settings, tap NEXT.
- 5. Enter your name which will be displayed on outgoing emails, tap **NEXT**.

Text and Picture Messaging

1. From the Home screen > Messages 回.

- 2. Tap **____** to begin a new message.
- 3. In the **To** field, enter a number or a contact name, or tap **Favorites or All Contacts** to select a contact from the address book.
- 4. Tap "Text Message" field and enter your text.
- 5. Touch it is send smileys & emotions, give access to Location, select in to send photos, videos, contact information, files, or sound recordings.

6. Tap to send the message.

How to replace the SIM

Install a SIM/microSD[™] Card

1. With the phone face down, remove back cover by gently pulling up on the indentation on the bottom left of the cover.



2. Insert the SIM card and microSD[™] card* with gold contacts facing down.



3. Ensure that SIM and microSD[™] cards have been properly secured.



4. Put the back cover on.

Turn on your new phone

- 1. Press and hold the Power/Lock key to turn on your phone.
- * microSDTM card sold separately

Easily Adjust Settings

Quick Settings

- 1. From the **Home screen**, drag your finger down to view the **Notifications panel**.
- 2. With the **Notifications panel** open, drag your finger down again to open the **Quick Settings menu**.
- 3. Tap **Settings** an the bottom middle to access the full Settings menu.

Secure Your Phone

- From Settings omenu, tap Security & biometrics.
- 2. Enable your lock/unlock method: Swipe, Pattern, PIN, Password, or Face Unlock.*
- 3. Face Unlock will unlock your phone using the front camera to register your face.

* Facial Recognition methods may not be as secure as Pattern, Pin, or Password locks.

Call Family & Friends

Make a Call

- From the Home screen >
 Tap Dialer to access the keypad, or select one of the following:
 - Choose frequently called or favorite contacts in Favorites *
 - Choose recently called numbers and contacts in **Recents** .
- Choose a saved contact in Contacts 🚢
- 3. Tap 💽 to place the call.



Capture Life's Moments

Take a Picture or Record a Video

- 1. From the Home screen > Camera 👩 .
 - To take a photo: Tap (a) or press the Volume up/down key to take a photo.
 - To take a video: From Camera > Video > Record () to start recording. Tap () to stop recording.

Camera features and settings

- 1. To select a different camera mode, tap an option above (a):
 - Video: Shoot and record videos.
 - Auto: The default camera mode will automatically adjust the focus, lighting, and more.
 - Portrait: Create a depth of field effect.
 - Pano: Capture a horizontally elongated field of view.
- 2. At the top of the camera screen, you can access camera settings image and video size image, High-Dynamic-Range image, enable a timer image, apply a real-time filter image or enable flash

Connect to Wi-Fi

- 1. From the **Home screen**, swipe down once.
- 2. Press and hold Wi-Fi 🛜 to open the Wi-Fi menu.
- 3. Tap ෩ to **turn on Wi-Fi**.
- 4. Tap a network name. Enter a password, if required, then tap **CONNEECT**.

Use Bluetooth

- 1. From the **Home screen**, swipe down once.
- 2. Press and hold **Bluetooth** to open the **Connected Devices menu**.



- 3. Tap **Pair new device** to turn **Bluetooth** on and display a list of available devices.
- 4. Tap the name of the device to initiate pairing.
