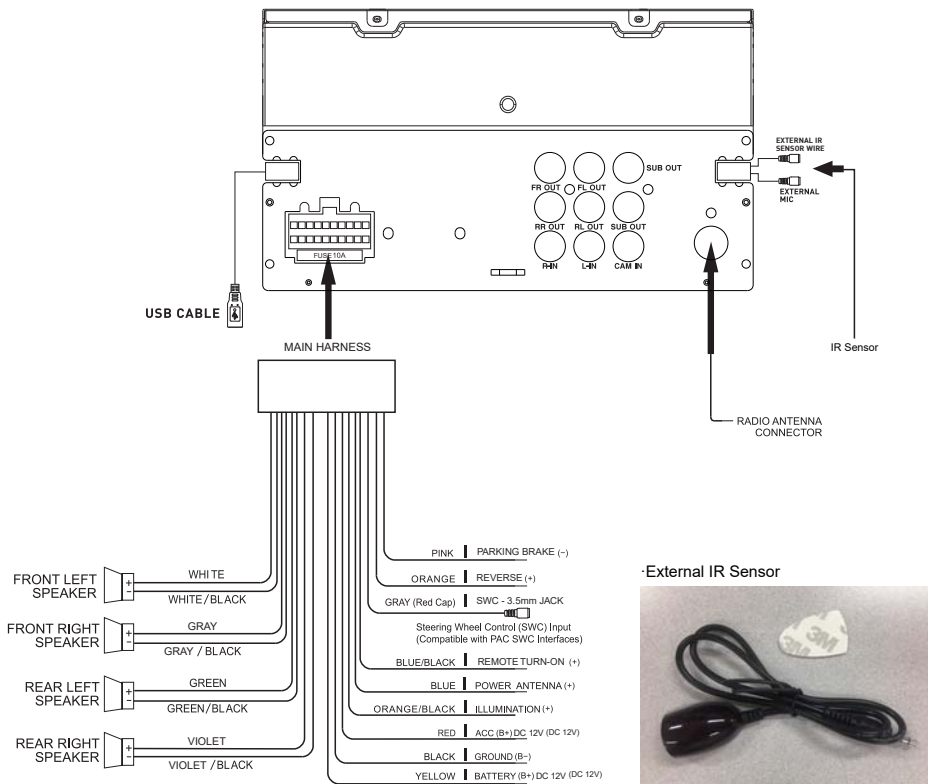

Wiring Diagram - Inputs/Outputs



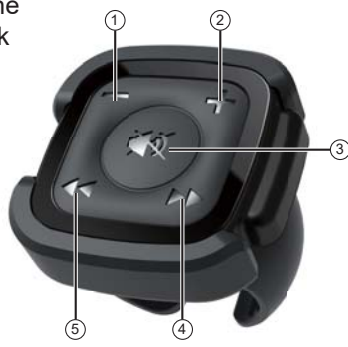
Control Locations



Remote Control

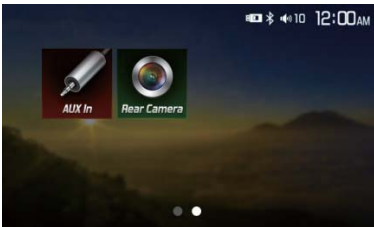
For best performance we recommend mounting the remote control between the 3 o'clock and 6 o'clock positions on the steering wheel.

1. Volume Down
2. Volume Up
3. Mute
4. Tune/Track Up
5. Tune/Track Down



Main Menu

In the Menu mode, press the desired icon to enter the corresponding mode: Radio, USB, BT Phone, BT Music, Android Auto, CarPlay, iPod, Settings, AUX In, Rear Camera



Tuner Operation

Select the Tuner icon from the Main Menu screen or press MODE until Tuner is selected.



USB Operation

Insert USB device in the USB slot, and the unit will read the USB device.

1. List
2. Repeat
3. Random
4. Track Down
5. Pause
6. Track Up

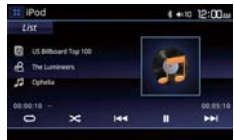


iPod Operation

To play MP3 files from an iPod, connect the device via USB and choose iPod from the Main Menu.

Note: The unit will automatically launch CarPlay any time a CarPlay enabled device is connected. To program the unit to launch in iPod mode instead, complete the following steps to disable CarPlay functionality from the iPhone

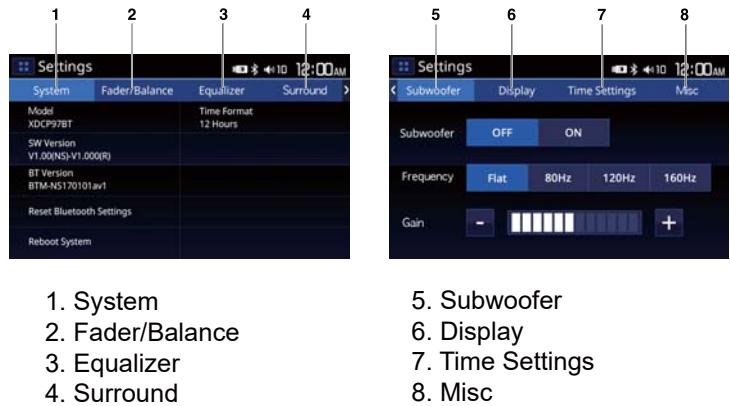
1. Remove the iPod cable from the unit if connected.
2. Enter the Settings of the iPhone and select General mode.
3. Select "Restrictions" in General mode (enter 0000 if a password is required).
4. Inactivate CarPlay.



Note: Older devices such as iPod nano and Classic do not support CarPlay function. When they are connected to the unit, they will only work in iPod mode

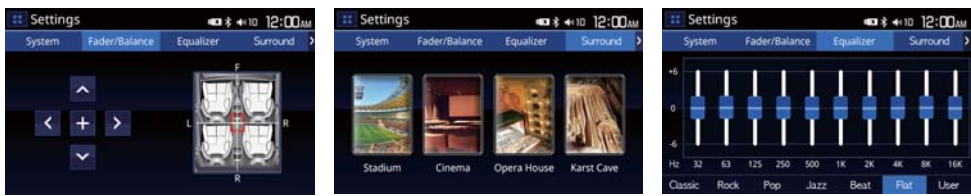
General Operation

Touch the Sub-Menu feature to be adjusted.



Audio Operation

Press the Settings icon on the main menu screen to adjust Fader and Balance controls, Equalizer (10-Band Tone Control and 7 Presets EQ Settings) and Surround Modes.

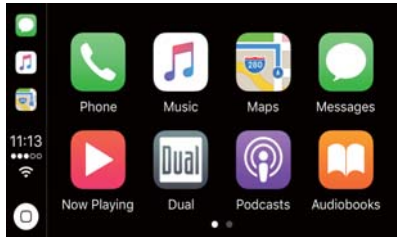


CarPlay Operation

Select **CarPlay** on the Main Menu.

If the iPhone is connected via USB port, press CarPlay icon on main menu to mirror the iPhone's apps onto the screen. If the iPhone USB cable is inserted to the USB port then the XDCPA9BT will automatically change to CarPlay mode.

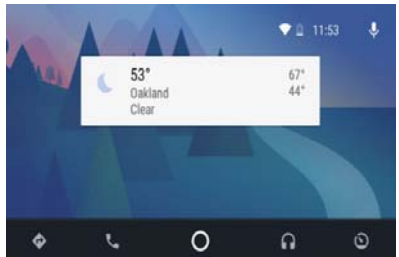


Android Auto Operation

Select **Android Auto** on the Main Menu.

If the Android Phone is connected via USB port, press Android Auto icon on main menu to mirror the Android Auto Basic Image onto the screen. If the Android Phone USB cable is inserted to the USB port then the XDCPA9BT will automatically change to Android Auto mode.

Bluetooth Operation

Bluetooth Microphone

The microphone is external and is included with the receiver.

Pairing and Connecting

Make sure that Bluetooth is activated on your device before you begin the pairing process. The unit broadcasts the pairing signal constantly when no devices are currently connected. Complete the pairing sequence from your Bluetooth device. The device name is "XDCPA9BT". The Bluetooth passcode is "0000". The unit can be in any mode of operation when pairing is performed. On certain phones, pairing may need to be done more than once.

Dialing a Number

Press **123456789** to display keypad and dial a number.

Making and Ending a Call

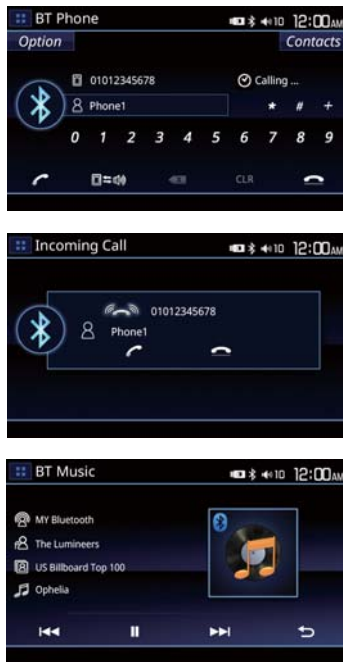
Press **Phone** to connect a call, and press **End Call** to end a call.

Transferring Audio

Press **Transfer** to transfer audio between the head unit and mobile phone.

Streaming Audio

Press **Play** to play or pause the music. Press **Previous** to skip to the previous track. Press **Next** to advance to the next track.
