I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that one of the requirements of a part 15 intentional radiator is that spurious and harmonic emissions must be lower than the fundamental. Consequently, while there may be no spurious emissions within 20dB of the limit above 30MHz, there can also be no emissions from the device that are higher than the fundamental. Please note that the 39dBuV/m reading taken at 3 meters must be shown to be the higher of all readings. Please provide evidence and or confirm that no spurious or harmonic emission from the device exceeds that of the fundamental..
