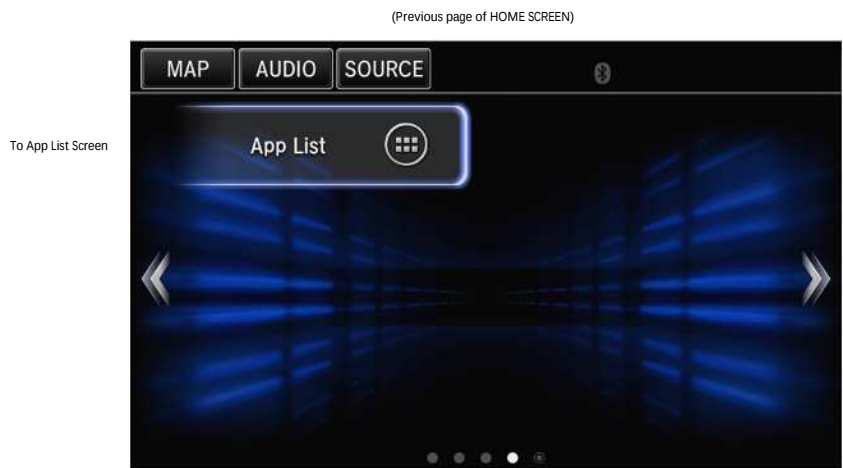
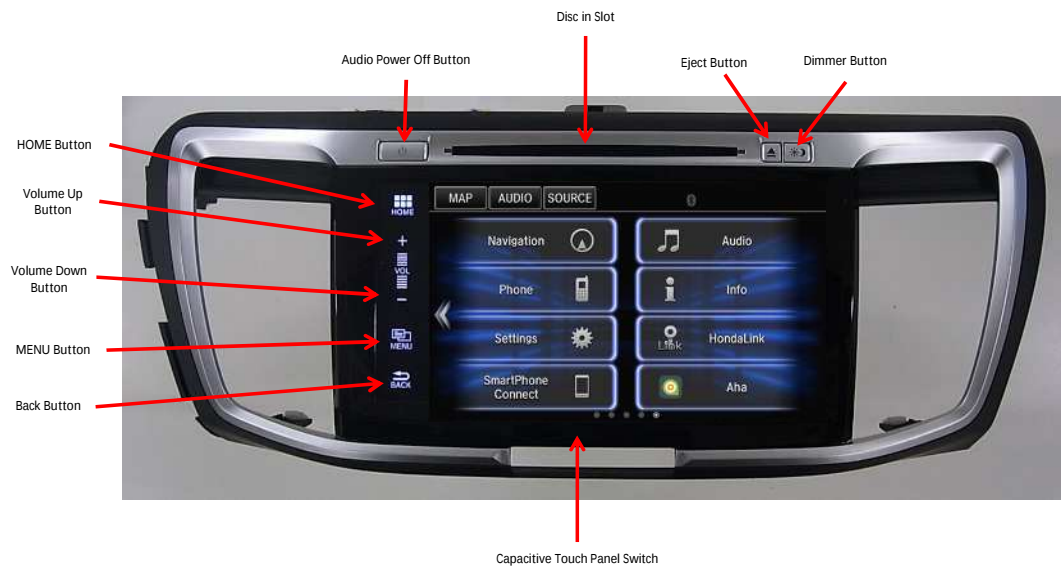

Operational Buttons

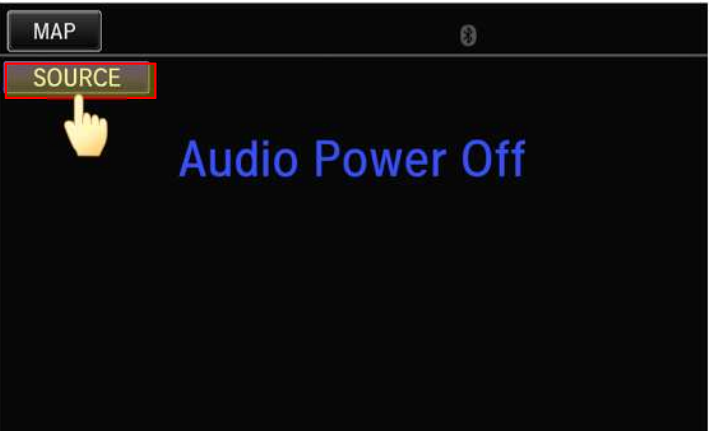


Note) There may be no button and different position in each models.

Ex.2: USB Audio play screen



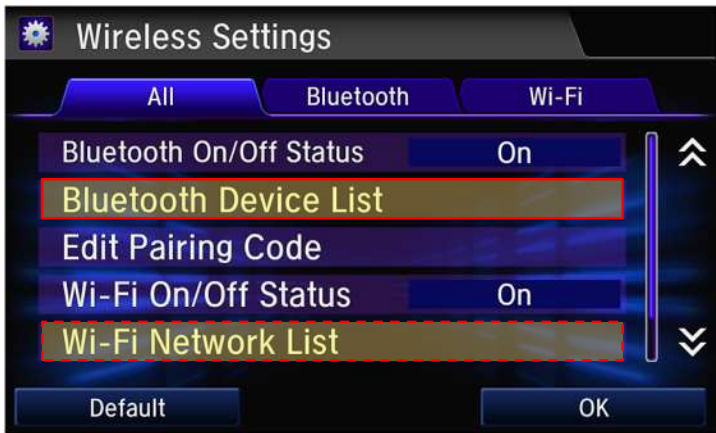
Bluetooth (Wi-Fi) Settings

When Status is Off, touch and set to On.

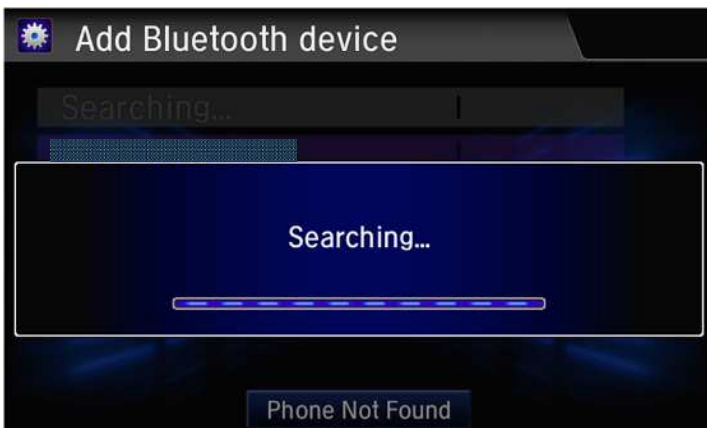




Touch Add Bluetooth Device button.
