Maintenance and Care

Do not use this product in a humid environment for a long time;

If there are stains on the surface, please wipe it with a dry cloth;

To reduce battery aging and expansion, regularly check the wires, plug ports and other parts for damage. If damaged, stop using it immediately until it is repaired.

If not used for a long time, charge it every three months or so.

Key Description

Print export



Charging port

Power button: long press for 3 seconds

Meaning of indicator lights

Green light: Power on

Green light: Device is not connected

Green light continues to flash: Device is successfully connected

Red light: Paper is out, device temperature is overheat and is not closed

Red light flashes: Low battery

Guidelines for use

Please charge before use; then press and hold the power key for 3 seconds to turn on.



Press the OPEN button in the direction indicated by the arrow to open the paper bin (note the direction of the machine).

Scan and download "easy tool" in App Store or Google.



Take out the old paper bin and put the new paper bin in the direction shown. The paper should be put straight and not skewed. Note: The new paper needs to be exposed to 2 cm of paper bin length so that the machine can catch paper automatically when printing.

After turning on the A4 printer, the picture will become lighter and lighter, which is a normal situation. Wait until it is adjusted to return to normal. If the battery has not been used for a long time or the battery is exhausted, it may take some time to start the machine immediately when recharging. Please continue charging for a period of time before starting the machine.

Turn off the device on your computer. Go to the website (www.brightprintable.com) on your Windows computer, download, and install the printer driver. Turn on the printer.

Open "Easy Tool" on your computer and select "99-2408".

Select the driver on your computer. Go to the website (www.brightprintable.com) on your Windows computer, download, and install the printer driver. Turn on the printer.

Connect the computer and the A4 printer using a Type-C/USB cable.

Open the document, click "Print," select the printer named "BRIGHT," and click "OK" to start printing, as shown in the figure.

Paper replacement course

Do not short-circuit the positive and negative poles of the battery.



Do not place the battery in a high-temperature of 60 °C near a fire source.

After the battery is removed in water, it is prohibited to use.

Contains small parts, not suitable for children under the age of 3.

Do not close to the fire when playing.

There is a risk of explosion when replacing the wrong type of batteries. Dispose of the used battery according to the instructions.

Note that the maximum temperature of the print head when printing is 10°C, please be careful not to touch.

Pay attention to the sharp cutting blade, please be careful not to touch.

This product does not belong to children's toys. Children under the age of 3 should be used under the supervision of adults.

According to our national compulsory product CCC certification standard, this product does not contain power adapter at the factory. If users use power adapter for power supply, they need to purchase supporting use CCC certification and meet the standard requirements of power adapter.

Remove or replace the printing carriage.
