I have a few comments on this Application. Please note that further comments may arise in response to answers provided to the questions below.

1. Please note that you have listed this device on the application as an original equipment. Please note that you have also listed an FCC ID in the 'Change in Identification' section of the 731. Is this a change in ID or is this an original equipment authorization? Please explain.
2. Please define the co-transmission characteristics of the device if any.
3. FYI – please note that the maximum BT power out is 1.2mw not 1.4mw. 1.2mw will be on the grant.
4. FYI – please note that TCBs can only approve devices that are tested to accepted FCC procedures. While the data in the WLAN/BT report appears to have been tested correctly, the report does not reference the accepted FCC test procedure nor does the test report provide information on the test methods as in accordance with the FCC accepted test procedures. In future, please make sure that all appropriate and proper test procedures are adequately explained in the test report.
