
- Touch the first gear of the switch to start the light,

### Wake function

When you set the alarm, the lights will automatically turn on slowly from dark to bright half an hour in advance. For example, the alarm clock is set to 7 o'clock, and the lights slowly turn on from dark to bright at 6:30.

• When the alarm clock enters the snooze state, the [ Z ] icon is displayed on the screenThe area flashes. • If the snooze is not over, touch and hold the night light switch to cancel the snooze state.
