After a review of the submitted information, I have a few comments on the above referenced Application.

- 1) The EUT appears to contain a MMX (or similar) connector besides the 2 internal antennas. Please confirm that the purpose of this connector for testing purposes only?
- 2) The 6 dB bandwidth measurement should be made with RBW = 100 kHz and VBW $\geq$ RBW. Please provide new test data for the 6 dB bandwidth using the correct settings.
- 3) For radiated measurements above 1 GHz, please explain the RBW and VBW settings used for the Average measurements.
- 4) The data for the Spectral Density Plots does not appear to match the data given in section 7 of the test report. Additionally, the plots do not appear as they normally should. It appears that the span is actually $\gg$ greater than 1.5 MHz shown. Please reverify the plots and test data given in the report.
