The Armrest Controller gives you the convenient access to key functions of your chair. Please use the Main Controller for full access to all of the chair's functions (see page 7).



Power Button

- ▶ Press to turn ON the massage chair.
- ► Press again to turn OFF the chair.



Rotary Switch

- ► Rotate clockwise to increase massage intensity.
- ▶ Rotate counterclockwise to decrease massage intensity.
- ► The stage are divided into 1-6 stage.



Pause Button

- ▶ Press to pause the massage function.
- ▶ Press again to resume the massage function.



Auto Button

▶ Press to switch between the automatic programs.



Airbag Button

▶ Press to turn ON/OFF and select the position of airbag.



Intensity Button

▶ Press to adjust the airbag pressure from level 1-3.



Zero Gravity Button

▶ Press repeatedly this button to activate one of the three zero gravity modes.



Backrest Up Button

- ▶ Press and hold to bring backrest up.
- Release when it reaches your desired position.



Foot Roller Button

Zero-G / Bluetooth Button

- ▶ Short press to select Zero Gravity position from 1-3.
- ▶ Long press this button to turn on/off the bluetooth function.



Back Up Button

- ▶ Long press this button to raise the backrest and lower the leg rest.
- Release it to lock the current angle.



Back Down Button



Function	Description
Master	Master mode, full body massage, and the intensity of roller and airbag massage are strong.
Spine Care	Widely use acupressure and scraping techniques, focusing on both sides of the spine massage to improve body microcirculation.
Soft	Suitable for the elderly and children, full body massage, rollor and airbag massage in the lightest way to improve back pain and leg cramp for the elderly.
Deep Sleep	Full body massage, push rod up/down, slow swing function, light intensity for rollers.
Neck & Shoulder	The partial massage focuses on improving neck pain and shoulder muscle strain, and the roller is focusing more on neck and shoulder massage.

The chair will not return to its initial position after finishing the Sleep Program. Please press the power button to return to the initial position.


INSTALLATION METHOD

STEP 1: Unpack All Parts

- ▶ Carefully lift the chair and all of its parts from packaging.
- ▶ Remove any protective wrapping and check to make sure that all parts are present.
- ▶ Before beginning installation, please verify all components are included.

STEP 2: Install the connection

▶ Connect the cable of remote controller with the cable under seat.





NOTE:

- ▶ Screw nut to scure it.






- ▶ Attach the pillow pad to the backresby connecting the zipper.





BEFORE USING THE MASSAGE CHAIR FOR THE FIRST TIME


- ▶ Make sure there are no objects, people, or pets in the vicinity of the unit.
- ▶ Check that the chair has room to recline. Allow at least 16 in. of open space infront of the legrest and 10 in. behind the backrest.
- ▶ Use the controller to lower the backrest to its furthest outstretched position.
- ▶ Raise the legrest to its highest position. Make sure that the legrest is properly connected to the chair.
- ▶ Press the power button to return the chair to its original, upright position.






MASSAGE CHAIR PLACEMENT

- ► Ensure adequate space to recline.
- ▶ Do not expose the massage lounger to direct sunlight or high temperatures, such as infront of heating sources because this can cause discoloration or hardening of the synthetic leather.
- ▶ Place the unit on a mat to pevent floor damage.
- ▶ Install the unit near a power socket.
- ▶ Be sure to place the chair within 4 ft of a power plug.



MOVE METHOD 1


- ▶ Turn off the main power and unplug the power from the electrical outlet.
- ▶ Tilt the chair backwards as shown below and wheel to desired location.
- ► Be sure to cover the floor with a mat when moving the massage chair to not damage the floor.



SETUP

MOVE METHOD 2

- ► Two people reach under the chair on each side of the arms and hold the steel frame to avoid damage to the rest of the chair.
- ▶ Move to desired location and carefully place the chair on the ground.





CAUTION

- ▶ Do not attempt to move the chair while someone is still sitting on it.
- ▶ Do not move the chair by pulling its armrests, as the armrests can dislodge.
- ▶ Before plugging it in, inspect the entire power cord and plug for any possible damage. Make sure that no electrical wires are exposed.
- ▶ Make sure that the power supply switch is turned OFF before inserting the power plug into a wall outlet.




GROUNDING INSTRUCTIONS

This unit must be grounded. If it should malfunction or breakdown, grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to reduce the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and ad grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

TURNING ON THE POWER

- ▶ Plug the power cord into the port at the base of the chair.
- Plug the three-pronged power plug into a properly grounded three-pronged power outlet.
- ► Flip on the power supply switch, located on the back of the massage chair at the base of the backrest.

DANGER

- ▶ This product is for use on a nominal 120V~ circuit and has a grounding plug that looks like the plug illustrated. Make sure that the product is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No adapter should be used with this product.
- ▶ Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product if it will not fit the outlet, have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.

PRODUCT STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE

CLEANING

- ▶ Before cleaning, switch OFF power and remove the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ Dip a soft, cotton cloth in neutral detergent and wring dry. Use it to wipe the pillow cushion, back cushion, armrests, legrests, and any plastic parts of the chair.
- ▶ Use a piece of wet cloth (without detergent) to re-wipe the pillow cushion and back cushion.
- ▶ Use a soft, dry cloth to re-wipe the armrests, legrests, and any plastic parts of the chair.
- ▶ Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the controller, and the power supply box.
- ▶ To clean the foot/calf unit covers, remove them from the chair, hand wash with mild detergent and hang dry.



CAUTION

- ▶ Before any maintenance, always disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet.
- ▶ To avoid electric shock, never touch the power plug with wet hands.
- ▶ When cleaning the back cover of the massage chair, do not allow any detergent to seep into the power supply box.
- ▶ Do not use abrasive chemicals, such as benzene or alcohol, to clean this chair. Damage to the chair may result.
- ▶ Do not apply an iron or any other heated device to the chair.

STORAGE

When not in use, be sure to switch off power and detach the power plug from the wall outlet. Before putting into storage, wipe off all accumulated dirt and dust from the surface of the chair. Cover the entire surface of the chair with a dust cover (not included).



CAUTION

- ▶ Do not store the product under direct sunlight, nor in a location with high temperatures. Doing so may cause the upholstery to fade.
- ▶ Do not allow massage chair to remain in contact with vinyl or wallpaper for extended periods of time as this could lead to discoloration.

MAINTENANCE

Upon detecting any of the following conditions during daily use, immediately turn off power, disconnect the power plug from the wall outlet, and contact an authorized repairman:

- ► A burning smell
- ► The power cord feels hot
- ► Any other abnormal functioning
- ▶ The cord is plugged in and the power switch flipped on, but no functions operate
