This response is with regard to item number one in your comments regarding

FCC ID: CJ6PA3121BT/EA102537

with respect to your request for a list of model numbers. Since our meeting at your office and most recently, a telephone conference with your Mr. Kwok Chan and Mr. Tim Harrington, it was agreed that instead of having to provide model numbers which use the WLAN and BT covered under these applications, which would defeat the purpose of "modular Approval" we are providing dimension for the location of the transmitters so that deviation due to installation in other similar notebooks is eliminated.

Please note the description, as follows:

The wireless Bluetooth module and wireless LAN module will be installed into Toshiba Laptop computers that satisfy the following conditions.

The antennas shall be located in the display section of the Laptop, above the LCD screen. The dimensions of the LCD section of the Laptops shall be constructed as to maintain a minimum of 20cm separation from the antennas and the user's body when the display is raised to its "normal" operating position. This 20cm distance will be measured vertically from the keyboard section of the Laptop to the bottom of the lowest antenna.

The installation of both the LAN and Bluetooth modules will require the use of 3 antennas, one for the Bluetooth module and two for the LAN module. The antennas shall be installed so that the Bluetooth antenna is located between the LAN's antennas. As viewed from the display, the left LAN antenna and the Bluetooth antenna shall be installed to maintain a minimum separation of 30mm, center to center. The right LAN antenna and Bluetooth antenna shall be installed to maintain a minimum separation of 75mm, center to center. The right LAN antenna shall also be installed to maintain a minimum of 50mm separation from the right most edge of the display section of the Laptop, center to edge.
