2.4 Placement of Compliance Information

Further to Section 2.1077(c), the compliance information must be provided in a form that an end-user can reasonably be expected to have the capability to access, such as the instruction manual, a separate product insert, computer disk, web page, or the device's own electronic screen. Compliance information may be provided electronically as permitted in Section 2.935.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

According to KDB 784748 section A2---When the device is so small, or for such use that it is impracticable to label it with the compliance statement specified in a font that is four-point or larger, and the device does not have a display that can show electronic labeling,¹⁸ then the information required shall be placed in the instruction manual, and on the device packaging or on a removable label attached to the device.

It's acceptable for our client to place the 15.19 statement in manual and packaging. Please correct me if my understanding is wrong.
