Therefore, before installing the camera, ensure that the live video can be played smoothly.

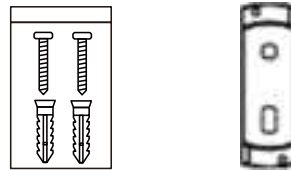
