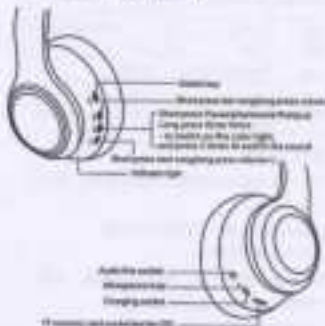

5. Keep the distance between the phone and the equipment within the meter's maximum detection range, the closer the better.
6. Press the "Infrared" button on the side of the remote right button and enter the pairing search mode.
7. Enable the Bluetooth function of the mobile phone, search the Bluetooth equipment, select for pairing and connection. After connection is successful, the blue indicator lamp of the receiver starts to blink.

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- The pairing mode will be maintained for 2 minutes. If pairing and connection are unsuccessful beyond 2 minutes, the headset will automatically return to the standby mode.
- After pairing is completed, the headset and the handset will remember each other, without pairing.
