JP-83412 ARM WALKIE TALKIE WITH FM SCAN RADIO INSTRUCTION MANUAL

TO REPLACE THE BATTERY FOR WALKIE-TALKIE AND RADIO

1. REMOVE THE SCREW ON THE BATTERY DOOR WITH A SCREW DRIVER.(SEE FIG. 2)

2.OPEN THE BATTERY DOOR AND INSERT ONE 6F22 9V BATTERY WITH CORRECT POLARITY INTO THE BATTERY COMPARTMENT. 3.REPLACE THE BATTERY DOOR AND THE SCREW ON POSITION.

WALKIE-TALKIE OPERATION:

1.TURN THE "WALKIE TALKIE /FM SELECTION SWITCH" TO "WT." POSITION.

2.PLUG THE EARPHONE INTO THE EARPHONE JACK.(SEE FIG.1) 3.PRESS THE " PUSH TO TALK" BUTTON TO TRANSMIT WHEN YOU SPEAK TO THE MICROPHONE. PRESS THE "MORSE CODE KNOB" AT THE SAME TIME TO TRANSMIT THE MORSE CODES.

4.RELEASE "PUSH TO TALK" BUTTON RECEIVING VOICE OR MORSE CODES.

5.TURN THE "WALKIE TALKIE/FM SELECTION SWITCH " TO "OFF" POSITION AFTER USED.

FM RADIO OPERATION:

- 1.TURN THE "WALKIE TALKIE /FM SELECTION SWITCH" TO "RADIO" POSITION.
- 2. PLUG THE EARPHONE INTO THE EARPHONE JACK.
- 3. PRESS THE "RESET BUTTON" ONCE TO SET THE FREQUENCY AT THE LOWEST SETTING.
- 4. PRESS THE "SCAN BUTTON" TO AUTOMATICALLY SEARCHING A STATION.
- 5. SUGGEST DON'T WALK WHEN SEARCHING A RADIO STATION, IF IT IS NOT YOUR DESIRED STATION, PRESS THE "SCAN BUTTON" AND TO SEARCH AGAIN. REPEAT THE ACTION, UNTIL SEARCH YOUR DESIRED STATION.

IF YOU HAVE PRESSED THE "SCAN BUTTON" A FEW TIMES AND NOT HEAR ANY SOUND FROM THE RADIO, THE RADIO MUST BE REACHED THE HIGHEST FREQUENCY. PRESS THE "RESET BUTTON" AGAIN TO START TUNING THE FREQUENCY AT THE LOWEST SETTING, AND PRESS "SCAN BUTTON" TO SELECT STATION AGAIN. 6.ROTATE THE "VOLUME KNOB" TO "OFF" POSITION AFTER USED.
