

PAIRING YOUR SPEAKER

Your speaker will work best if it is within 30 ft. of your smart device. You may experience sound briefly cutting off if you are out of range or if your wireless connection is weak. Make sure Bluetooth® is enabled on your smart phone or tablet before starting the pairing process.

PAIRING YOUR SPEAKER (continued)

Make sure the speaker is turned off before attempting to pair it with a smart phone or tablet. Press the "ON/OFF" button to turn on the speaker.
