

# A CLOSER LOOK




- 1, Volume + Button
- 2, Volume Button
- 3, Display Screen 4, Charging Port

#### **CHARGING**

Insert the USB-C plug of the included USB-C charging cable into the charging port on your headphones,



Insert the other end of the USB cable into a suitable USB charging adapter,



When charging, the headphones' indicator light turns red, When fully charged, the light turns blue,

Charging can take approximately 2-3 hours,



Note: Remove the charging cable when the headphones are fully charged,

To preserve battery quality, do not overcharge the headphones,


A charged battery will lose capacity if not used regularly,

To avoid a complete discharge of the battery, make sure to charge and use your headphones at least once every six months,

# POWERING ONIOFF


Press and hold the Volume + button for approximately two seconds to turn ON the headphones, Press and hold the Volume + button for approximately three seconds to power OFF the headphones,

Note: It is recommended that the headphones be fully charged before use,



### BLUETOOTH PAIRING

When the headphones are powered ON the indicator light on the headphones will flash between red and blue signifying it has entered pairing mode,





Go to the Bluetooth settings menu on your phone, Make sure Bluetooth is ON, Connect to the device listed as "RBK5OO2",

After connecting the headphones the indicator light will slowly flash blue,

# USING YOUR HEADPHONES

Button	Function
Volume + Button¦	Press and hold for 2 seconds to power ON, Press and hold for 3 seconds to power OFF, Press to increase volume, Press and hold for 2 seconds to go to the next track, Press 2 times to play/pause, Press 3 times to activate Voice Assistant on compatible devices, While there is an incoming call;
	Press to accept/end a call, Press and hold for 2 seconds to reject a call,
Volume - Button¦	Press to decrease volume, Press and hold for 2 seconds to go to the previous track,



To prevent possible hearing damage, do not listen at high volume levels for long periods, For your own safety, please be aware of your surroundings when using these headphones,

#### MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- -Use a soft cloth or paper towel to clean your headphones, Never use any harsh chemicals or detergents for cleaning, Make sure your headphones are dry before charging,
- -When your headphones are unused, they should be stored in a cool, dry place,
- -Never tug or yank on a cable while it is connected to your headphones, Connect and disconnect cables as carefully as possible,
- -Never expose your headphones to high temperatures or extreme cold,
