### Behaviour of WTA

#### **Turn ON**

- Long press for 2 seconds to turn ON
- Tag goes to pairing mode for 30s.
  - o LED blink indication for pairing duration.
  - o No LED indication for tag advertisements.


#### **Turn OFF**
