

GETTING STARTED

Battery charging

The tablet has a built-in rechargeable Li-polymer battery. To charge connect the AC power adapter to the USB jack on the left side of the tablet and the battery icon shows the battery status and charging status.

The tablet can be used even if the battery is being charged. No replacement of battery without authorization, or the explosion hazard might happen. Recharge it for at least half hour if it has been idle for long time and fails to start itself. Regularly recharge it at least one time monthly. 35° - 5° is the optimum temperature for the battery recharging or the battery performance might deteriorate slightly.



- 2. The PC will detect an external disc named T1021P/T1021T, this is the internal memory of the tablet.
- 3. Then slide down from top to inside, click "USB for charging". Choose "File transfers", then you can transfer files from computer to the device. Please check below image for reference.




