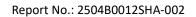

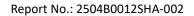

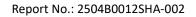

2.2 Assessment Results

Power density (S) is calculated according to the formula:

 $S = PG / (4\pi R^2)$

Where $S = power density in mW/cm^2$

P = Radiated transmit power in mW

G = numeric gain of transmit antenna

R = distance (cm)

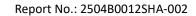
As we can see from the test report 2504B0012SHA-001:

The calculations in the table below use the highest gain of antenna for client EUT. These calculations represent the worst case in terms of the exposure levels.
