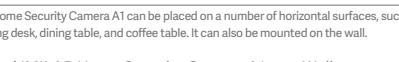

Installation

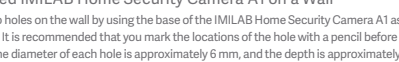
IMILAB Home Security Camera A1 can be placed in a number of horizontal surfaces, such as a window blind, ceiling table, and ceiling wall, from the back mounted on the wall.

Mounted IMILAB Home Security Camera A1 on a Wall

1. Use two holes on the wall by using the level of IMILAB Home Security Camera A1 as a template. It is recommended that you mark the location of the hole with a pencil before drilling. The diameter of each hole has approximately 1mm, and the depth is approximately 20mm.



2. Insert the hexaplastic anchors into the holes on the wall.



3. Make sure to position the base unit as that the arrow is pointing down. Remove the base unit by turning the hexaplastic anchors clockwise.

4. The mounting process is the bottom of the camera unit with the stand area on the base unit. Please do not touch the surface with bare hands. After the base is secured with an electric screwdriver in position.

Warning:

- Do not use any chemicals or liquids. The device must be securely fastened to the floor wall or the ceiling of the installation instructions.
- Do not touch the lens or the IR LED.
- Do not touch the lens or the IR LED. The lens is made of plastic and is easy to be scratched or stained.
- To avoid fire, the camera should be able to support at least 10A product's load weight.

Product Instructions

Turning the Device On

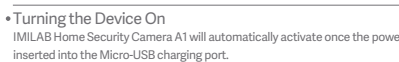
Press the power button on the back of the camera unit to automatically activate over the power cable it is connected to the USB charging port.




1. The indicator light is flashing orange, that means the device is activated successfully. If you do not see a flashing orange light, please turn on the Reset button to restart the device's camera system.

2. To turn on the camera, please connect the camera to a power source to activate it.

3. To find the home, the camera should be in a correct location, adjustments can be made through the App.



Indicator Light

Ready state: the extended red light status is normal. Flashing orange indicates an error.

Flashing orange light: waiting for connection.

Flashing orange light system: system upgrade.

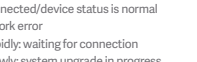
Installing the MicroSD Card

1. The IMILAB Home Security Camera A1 is already designed.

2. After the camera has opened up, the MicroSD card is inserted. Then insert the MicroSD card for the data storage on the camera. Please be aware of the Insert Arrow.

Note: Please turn off the IMILAB Home Security Camera A1 power supply before inserting or removing the MicroSD card. Please use approved MicroSD card.

Reset Factory Settings

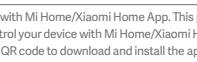
Press and hold the Reset button to restore the camera to factory settings. Once the device is the MicroSD card is deleted.

Install Mi Home App

Connect with Mi Home Security Camera App. This product works with Mi Home/Security Camera App. Connect your phone with Mi Home Security Camera App.

Scan the QR code to download and install the app. You will be directed to the connection and setup page. The app is available on Google Play, the App Store, and Huawei App Store. The app stores download and install it. Open Mi Home Security Camera App. Tap "I am the eye right, and then follow the steps to install and activate.

The app requires an Mi Home app ID (except for Russia). The names of the app developer are: gsm-privacy@mi.com and mi.com.



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
