Dear FCC Representative;

Reference part 90.203(e), frequency programming capability.

The end user will not be able to program the channel frequencies. A service shop or authorized agent using a special programming cable and computer software can program the allowed TX/RX frequencies. The end user can only select from the preprogrammed channels using the channel select knob. The software and programming cable are not available to the end user.
