### **Product Descrition:**

This document is to specify the product requirements for 802.11a/b/g/n/ac and Bluetooth USB Module. This Card is based on REALTEK RTL8822BU chipset. It is a complete dual-band(2.4GHz and 5GHz)/WIF12 × 2 MIMO MAC/PHY/Radio System-on-a-Chip. This module provides a high level of integration with a dual-stream IEEE 802.11ac MAC/ base band /radio and Bluetooth 4.1 and 4.2LE. The WLAN operation supports 20MHz,40MHz and 80MHz channels for data rates up to 866.7Mbps. It is also backward complied with IEEE 802.11a standard from 5.15~5.825GHz wideband and IEEE 802.11b/g standard from 2.4~2.5GHz. It can be used to provide up to 54Mbps for IEEE 802.11a and IEEE 802.11g, 11Mbps for IEEE 802.11b and 300Mbps for IEEE 802.11n.

When something wrong happens in configuring test modes for host product with module, host product manufacturer should coordinate with module manufacturer for technical support. It is recommended that some investigative measurements should be taken to confirm that host product with module installed does not exceed the spurious emissions limits or band edge limits.
