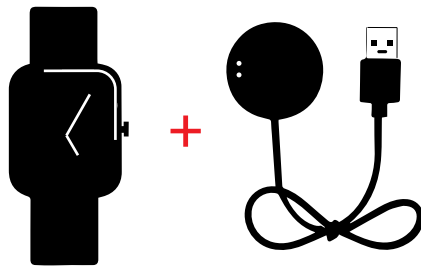

## UNPACK CONTENTS

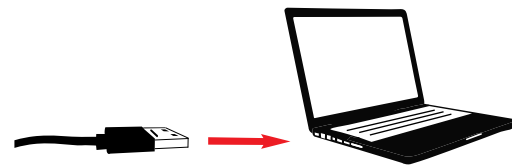
Locate watch and charging cable in box.

## CHARGING

Insert cable into a computer USB port or UL-certified wall charger.



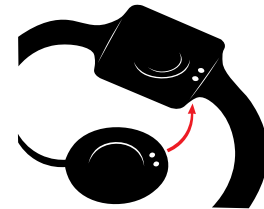
*Note: avoid using fast-chargers*

## FULLY CHARGE WATCH

Line up metal pins on charging cable with contacts on back of watch and lower until it snaps into place.  
Charge for 2-3 hours.

Magnetic charging cable snaps into place.



A charging screen will appear to confirm your watch is charging.

Scan QR code with your smartphone camera to download our free mobile app.

## PAIR YOUR WATCH

Power on watch (press and hold button for 5 seconds), open the mobile app, create an account, then tap watch icon to begin pairing. Pairing sets time and date on your watch.

*Note: enable Bluetooth on your phone but only pair your watch using mobile app.*

## **FCC Statement**
