Tips

1. Dear users, for your better experience with this product, please fully charge it before use.

2. Please use a DC5V charger and a computer to charge the headset. Do not use DC9V, DC12V, DC24V to charge the headset.

3. This product has been idle for a long time, please recharge it within 2 months to ensure good battery performance.

4. After wearing this product, it is recommended to use a dry towel to dean the sweat and water stains on the surface of the product, and leave it for 2 hours to ensure that the charging port is dry before charging the headset to prevent the short circuit of sweat during charging and affecting the service life of this product.

5. Long-term high-volume music may cause discomfort. Please try to use a medium or so volume to avoid listening at high volume for a long time.

6. Do not throw, press the headset or submerge it in water. Stay away from fire, water and high pressure equipment.
